

- POSITION 1 **NEUTRAL POSITION**
- POSITION 2 FIRST CLICK
- POSITION 3

 Unscrew the crown cover to access the crown . to wind up and start the watch, turn the crown @ clockwise. POSITION 1 NEUTRAL POSITION **POSITION 2** press the pusher 3 to bring the crown 6 to position 2. Turn the crown 6 clockwise to set the desired date 6. FIRST CLICK **POSITION 3** press the pusher 3 again to bring the crown 6 to position 3. Turn the crown 6 clockwise to set the desired time. Consider SECOND CLICK the indicator (24 hours) for the correct click of the date (0.

2. Press the crown all the way down to return it to position 1. Carefully screw down the crown cover until it locks completely.





To avoid misalignment or breakage of the date click wheel when setting the date, make sure that:

- 1. When resetting the date manually, the hand is not positioned between 21 and 03 o'clock (refer to the 24 hours indicator if necessary).
- **2.** The day \odot indicated by the date window is aligned with the window (see figure alongside).
- **3.** Bring the crown to position 3, position the watch hand at 3 o'clock, bring the crown to position 2, move the date to the desired day paying attention to point 2.



Press the (on/off) pusher • to start the chronograph hand and the hours/minutes totalizer.

Press the pusher o again to stop the chronograph, which will restart by pressing it again.



- Your watch will keep its performance intact for a long time, with proper care.
- We recommend that you have your watch checked every 3-4 years at one of our Authorized Dealers/Authorised Service Centres, to carry out ordinary maintenance on all mechanical parts and water resistance.
- $\,^{\circ}$ We also recommend contacting an Authorized Dealer/Authorised Service Center to replace the strap.
- Do not leave the watch in places exposed to extreme temperature changes, humidity, the sun and strong magnetic fields.
- Make sure the watch is suitable for use in water.
- Always rinse the watch with fresh water after contact with salt water.
