

- POSITION 1
   NEUTRAL POSITION
- POSITION 2
  FIRST CLICK
- POSITION 3

1. Unscrew the cap crown (a) to gain access to the crown (e).

**POSITION 3** 

SECOND CLICK

POSITION 1 to wind and start the watch by turning the crown clockwise.

POSITION 2 press button 3 to move the crown 6 into position 2 (first click). Turn the crown 6 clockwise to set the date 6.

press button 3 again to move the crown 6 into position 3 (second click). Use indicator 5 for correct date change 6.

2. Fully depress the crown 6 to move it back into the neutral position. Carefully screw in the cap crown 2 until firmly in place.





To prevent misalignment or breakage of the date wheel when setting the date, make sure that:

- 1. During manual adjustment of the date ②, hour hand ③ is not pointing between 9 pm and 3 am (check the 24 hour hand ③).
- 2. The day indicated by the date indicator o is aligned with the window (see the picture next)
- **3.** Take the crown **③** out to the second click, move the hand **⑤** to 3 pm, depress the crown **⑥** to the first click and move the date indicator **⑥** to the desired date and check the alignment as indicated in point 2 above.



#### CHRONOGRAPH OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

Press button • to start the chronograph and the hour/minute totalizer.

Press button • again to stop the chronograph and read the elapsed times.

Press button (3) to reset the counter.



- The precision mechanism in your watch will provide long-lasting performance when properly cared for.
- We recommend taking your watch to an Authorised Retailer/Authorised Service Centre every 3-4 years for a check-up and to perform ordinary maintenance on all mechanical parts and restore of water-resistance.
- $^{\circ}$  We also advise taking your watch to an Authorised Retailer/Authorised Service Centre to change the strap.
- Avoid leaving your watch where it is exposed to large temperature variations, humidity, the sun and strong magnetic fields.
- Make sure the watch is in adequate conditions for water use/activities.
- Remember to rinse the watch after it comes into contact with seawater.
